DIRECTIONS

From points east and west of Farmington Take I-84 to Exit 39. Turn right at the first traffic light onto Route 4 East (Farmington Ave.) Stay in the left lane for 0.6 miles through two sets of lights. At the third light, turn left to enter The Exchange office complex, located directly across the street from the University of Connecticut Health Center main campus entrance.

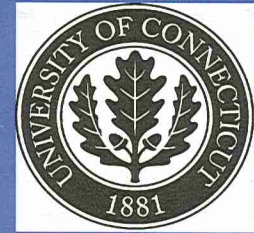

Clinical Services at the Division of Occupational and Environmental Medicine

The Division of Occupational and Environmental Medicine is dedicated to improving the health and safety needs of workers, employers, and the environment by providing outstanding clinical services for the diagnoses and treatment of complex and often unusual medical conditions related to the workplace or environmental exposures. Our Specialty Diagnostic Clinic serves as a premier regional resource providing Occupational and Environmental Medicine diagnostic and treatment services.

We provide a multidisciplinary approach to the evaluation of complex medical problems by combining thorough medical evaluation of patients with detailed assessment of occupational and/or environmental exposures that could be contributing to the medical problems.

Our exposure assessment often involves site visit to the worksite or home by our experienced industrial hygienists. This often leads to identification of hazards that can be eliminated or reduced, leading to improvement of the patient's clinical condition and a reduction of risk for others.
